COVID-19 Safety In Our Office

Virginia Health Center is taking every precaution to keep our patients safe. We are following CDC and VDH recommendations.

Scheduling

We will ask you a series of questions about your symptoms and possible exposure to Covid-19 to determine the best plan of care. In addition to seeing you in the office, a Telehealth/video-consult may also be an option.

Lobby

Our common areas, including door handles, chairs, and tables are cleaned and disinfected frequently throughout the day. All reading material has been removed. We are practicing social distancing and patients may wait outside or inside their vehicle after they check in.

Face coverings

Patients are informed when they schedule appointment that a face covering or mask must be worn to their appointment. Visitors must wear a face covering or mask to enter the facility. All staff members are required to wear a mask.

Checking in and out

When information in writing is required, pens, clipboards, credit card machines are disinfected between uses.

Hand Hygiene

Sanitizer is located throughout the facility and in each exam room. Patients are encouraged to use the sanitizer upon entering and upon exiting our office.
